2024 Youth Cohort *she's Electable*, Nebraska LLC

What is it?

This group will be comprised of a diverse group of ten to twenty young people between the ages of 16 and 21 who apply to design, and then create and execute, ways to engage young Nebraskans in politics and grassroots organizing. Applicants should align with the progressive mission of <u>She's</u> <u>Electable</u>, but do not need to see themselves as members or adherents to any political party or philosophy. The cohort's work will focus at the state level to increase young voter turnout and youth engagement to demonstrate the power of youth to affect what happens in Nebraska politics. The cohort's work will officially end with the November election, with the possibility of renewing or recreating it.

What is it NOT?

It is NOT run by adults over the age of 21. The work will be designed by the cohort and the adults supporting the work and organizing with the cohort will not be the primary decision makers. Our job will be to listen, co-create, and stay out of the way.

It is NOT unfunded. The cohort will have a substantial budget to support their vision and the work they create. Each member of the cohort will receive a minimum \$500 stipend.

It is NOT party affiliated or bound by "traditional politics." *She's Electable* cares about public education, human rights, access to housing and medical care, and broadly anything that advocates for change that reduces barriers for women and femmes in Nebraska.

The work will start in July, with a meeting tentatively scheduled for July 11th or 12th, and with official work starting July 15th to plan action steps envisioned by the group for the months of August,



September, October and November up to the election. The level of commitment and participation will be flexible to make room for other commitments. Youth with higher levels of activity and commitment might receive higher stipends.
